Getting It Together Scheme GITS

GITS is an early intervention brokerage program designed to assist vulnerable young people with alcohol and/or drug problems.

This brokerage service is available for young people residing in the Penrith, Hawkesbury and Blue Mountains LGA's and the Mt Druitt area. The brokerage is designed to assist young people to live self-sufficiently, free of dependence on alcohol and/or drugs.

Eligibility

1. People aged 12 to 25 years, with priority given to those under 18
2. Experienced alcohol and/or drug problems
3. Have goals to address AOD support, health, mental health, justice, education, employment, relationships, independent living that are supported by a case plan.

The scheme is flexible with funds able to be used to access employment, education and training, specialist services like therapy or rehab, transition into stable safe accommodation or in a targeted way to help a young person manage alcohol and drug issues and lead an independent life. Your application must show how the young person will be able to use the funds to achieve these goals.

Each application must have a completed referral form with an accompanying income statement. If an income statement is not available, please call MYC Referrals to discuss alternative options.

Each application will be assessed on an individual needs basis.
